News from the Director

The library has applied for two grants during the month of December. One grant would allow us to purchase up to 10 additional hotspots available to patrons for checkout from the library. Hotspots are devices that give an internet connection to individuals who may not have internet service in the area that they live in. The library allows patrons to check these out for one week at a time. The waiting list is consistently 2-3 months long! This would allow us to cut down on wait time for a service that our community really needs.

The second grant is the Southwest Community grant. We applied for a grant so that the library can further expand its offerings by way of STEM kits. STEM stands for science, technology, engineering, and mathematics. STEM kits promote reading and learning in one for children of all ages. The goal with these kits, is to offer some for checkout (which could be very beneficial to our homeschool community) as well as have some kits in the library which would be used for another programming opportunity .

The library will be hosting a Friends of the Library (FOL) Open House. The FOL is a group that advocates, supports, and fundraises on behalf of the library. FOL groups are extremely important and we would like to get our group going again! The open house will provide information to those interested in becoming a FOL so that we can get a group of primary members that will hold office as well as find individuals who would like to be a member, but not hold office.
