Library COVID-19 Update

We modified our reopening plan to be a six phase reopening plan. As of July 1, 2020, we are in our fifth phase.

This phase allows patrons to enter the library, use the computers with a one hour time limit, and we have resumed ILL services! All returned items are being quarantined for 72 hours before being shelved and/or redistributed. All computers are cleaned after each use and throughout the day we clean touched surfaces. At the end of each day, we conduct a final thorough cleaning of all high traffic areas.
