### **Library COVID-19 Update**

*All information is as of January 1, 2021.* The library currently is open but with limited services- curbside services for pickup of materials, faxes, prints, copies, and library cards. We are allowing one hour appointments to be made for use of computers, the TN Room, to browse the book sale or for use of our wi-fi inside the building with a device.

You can request items by emailing or calling the library with a list of authors, genres, or titles or by asking for a customized mystery bag. We do also have a listing of books that were added to our collection over the last month. We will still have hotspots circulating. When it is your turn for a hotspot (current waiting time is approximately one month) you will be called and an appointment scheduled to pickup your hotspot. You will need to make an appointment to drop your hotspot off the following week as well.
