Library COVID-19 Update

All information is as of November 1, 2020. The library is currently restricting access to no more than 25 individuals in the library at a time. Masks are recommended but not required at this time. We do ask that patrons continue to practice good hygiene and social distancing. Patrons can browse the shelves for materials and may select their own books, DVDs, or audiobooks. We are still offering curbside pickup and contactless delivery by use of our online registration system. We have five computers available for use– no appointments are necessary. There is still an one hour time limit on all computer sessions and we request that all patrons limit their time in the library to one hour.
